Class 1: Intro C 2016 - Restricted / Open

Kindly sponsored by Pony Magic

- Any Horse and Rider combination which has come 1st or 2nd in a dressage competition does not qualify to ride in the restricted section.
- Any Horse and Rider combination which has competed at Elementary Level or competed at Intermediate Horse Trials do not qualify to ride in the restricted section.
- A Best Member Rosette to the highest placed member.

Class 2: Prelim 2 (2016) – Restricted / Open

Kindly sponsored by Madgwick Carriage Masters

- Any Horse and Rider combination which has come 1st or 2nd in a dressage competition does not qualify to ride in the restricted section.
- Any Horse and Rider combination which has competed at Elementary Level or competed at Intermediate Horse Trials do not qualify to ride in the restricted section.
- A Best Member Rosette to the highest placed member.

Class 3: Prelim 7 (Revised 2016)

Kindley sponsored by Aviex Ltd

- A Best Member Rosette to the highest placed member.

Class 4: PYO Novice 24(Revised 2016), Novice 27(2007), Elementary 44 (2002)

Kindley sponsored by SRC Quadrille Team

- Competitors may ride more than one test
- A Best Member Rosette to the highest placed member.

In addition the highest placed junior rider (under 18) in each class will receive a special rosette – please state age on entry form.

Arenas: Warm up and tests to be ridden on a surface.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All persons entering the show ground shall be bound by these rules and regulations.
2. The Organising Committee do not accept liability for damage, any accident or injury of any kind to any person, animal or property whatsoever.
3. British Riding Club members are covered by BRC Third Party insurance. Anyone attending the show who is not a BRC member must have their own liability insurance.
4. There will be a qualified first aider on site and medical emergencies covered by standard 999 call out.
5. The Judges decision is final.
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry/entries without reason, alter the time, date and schedule and allocation of prizes.
7. Any competitor who, in the eyes of the judges ill treats or causes unnecessary suffering to any horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground.
8. No horse or pony may be entered in the same class more than once except for class 4 PYO, where the same horse/rider combination can ride more than one test.
9. It is regretted that no entry fees can be refunded.
10. Objections must be made in writing and given to the Secretary within 15minutes of the incident, with a deposit of £5.00, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
11. Correct riding dress must be worn along with a hard hat conforming to BRC rules. For details on hat standards go to <http://www.area17-brc.org.uk/brc-hat-standards-for-2012/>
12. No Haynets to be tied to the outside of Lorries or trailers and all droppings and litter **MUST** be removed from the car park.
