

## Rules

1. All persons entering the show ground agrees to these rules and regulations.
2. The organisers do not accept liability for damage, any accident or injury of any kind to any person, animal or property whatsoever and howsoever caused on the premises.
3. The judge's decision is final. This includes decisions made using a stop clock for timing rounds.
4. The show and its judging will be run under British Eventing rules.
5. Entry fees will not be refunded after midday on the closing date unless a valid veterinary certificate is produced.
6. No horse or pony may be entered into the same class more than once.
7. Any competitor who, in the eyes of the judge or member of the organising committee, treats or causes unnecessary suffering to any horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground.
8. Eventing attire must be worn at all times including hard hat to current approved British Standard with the chinstrap properly fastened when mounted.
9. Objections must be made in writing and given to the Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident with a deposit of £10.00, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
10. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years to be competed.
11. No lunging or galloping in the warm up arena.
12. The organisers reserve the right to cancel classes, withhold or reduce prize money if there are limited/insufficient entries.
13. Opening date for entries will be the day after the previous arena eventing show.

**Arena eventing is a two phase competition where competitors jump a course of show jumps followed immediately by a course of cross country fences. The cross country round will be based on an optimum time.**

The show jumping will start with a whistle, after the last show jump there will not be a second bell but riders may circle before or take a direct line to the first cross country fence.

The winner will be the horse with the lowest penalty score, closest to the optimum time at the end of the class.

Knockdown	4 penalties
1 <sup>st</sup> disobedience	4 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> disobedience	8 penalties
3 <sup>rd</sup> disobedience	Elimination
Fall of rider	8 penalties
2 <sup>nd</sup> fall of rider	Elimination
Fall of horse	Compulsory retirement
Retaking an obstacle already jumped	Elimination

**Dress code** – cross country attire and body protectors must be worn for both phases.

## Classes

- Class 1: 60cm Open (Approx. 2')**
- Class 2: 70cm Intro (Approx 2'3")**
- Class 3: 80cm (Approx 2'7")**
- Class 4: 85cm (Approx 2'9")**
- Class 5: 90cm (Approx 3') several fences will be 1m.**

## Warm Up

Warm up will be in the 20x40 arena. For safety reasons competitors will be allowed to warm up for 20 minutes and then called to the competition arena (max 4 horses warming up at once). A practice fence will be in the warm up arena and competitors can jump two designated practice fences in the competition arena before starting.

## Surfaces

Both competition and warm up on surfaces.
