

Guidelines for the current COVID-19 situation.

Vaccinations – We kindly ask you that your horses vaccinations are up to date. The booster injection must be given within 6 months prior to the competition. We do understand that due to COVID-19 your vets may not have been able to come out to you, so in these circumstances you will need at least the up to date annual boosters. **Onward from the 30th September we will be only accepting the 6 month flu vaccination booster** as there as been enough time for vets to come and do the booster.

Catering – We have asked Jane and Richard at Taste buds catering and they are very happy to come along but we will be asking for a queuing system so that we can keep people away from each other and also away from the caterers themselves.

Results and sheets – We would like to ask that you bring with you an **A5 £2 stamped address envelope** so we can send you your test sheet/rosette so there is no waiting around and minimises numbers on the yard. All Results will be added to our website either that evening or the next day.

Spectators – We ask that you only bring 1 or 2 people with you so we can keep the numbers down on the show ground to minimize over crowded areas such as the arenas and the catering/photographer. Whilst on site competitors and visitors are asked to maintain the 2-metre rule.

Managing hygiene -

- Frequent cleaning with disinfectant, paying close attention to common touchpoints like door handles, gates, counters etc. and any shared equipment, such as pens, clipboards etc.
- Hand washing facilities with soap and hand sanitiser available at all times whenever possible for visitors/participants. Visitors and competitors are asked to be mindful not to touch unnecessary things.

Theses rules are inline with any government changes.
